

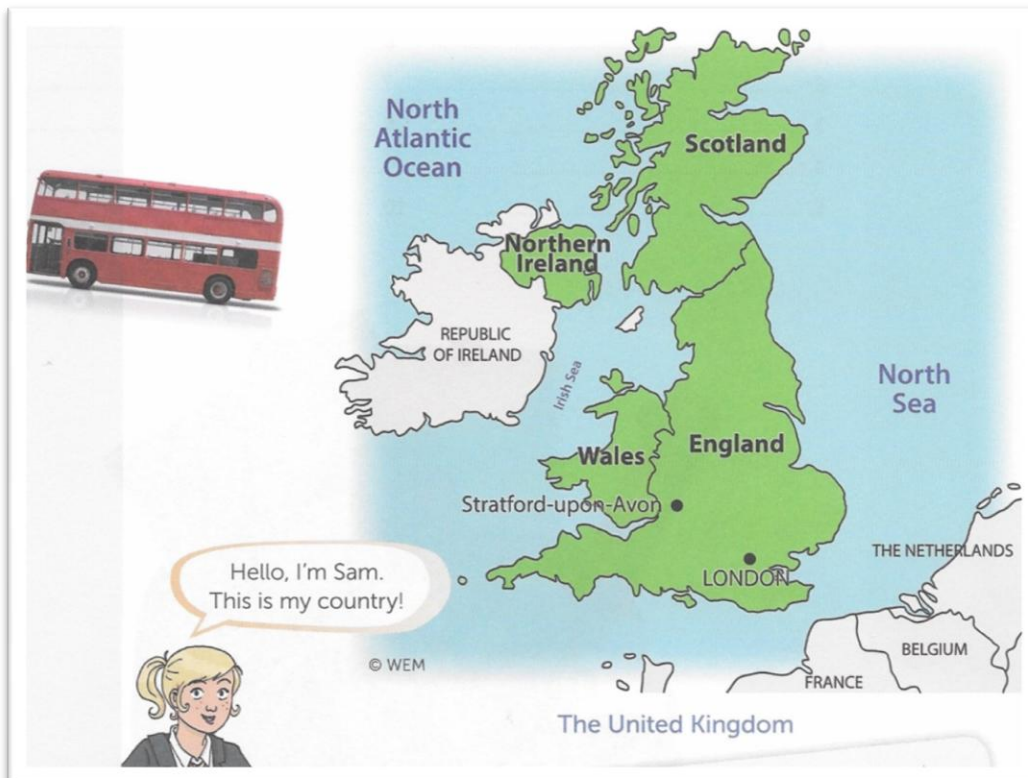

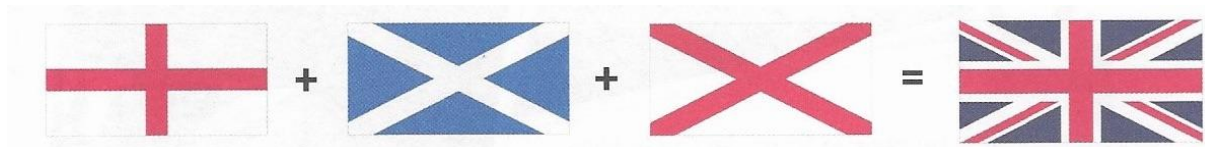
**What are the different parts in the flag?**

**For England: a red cross**

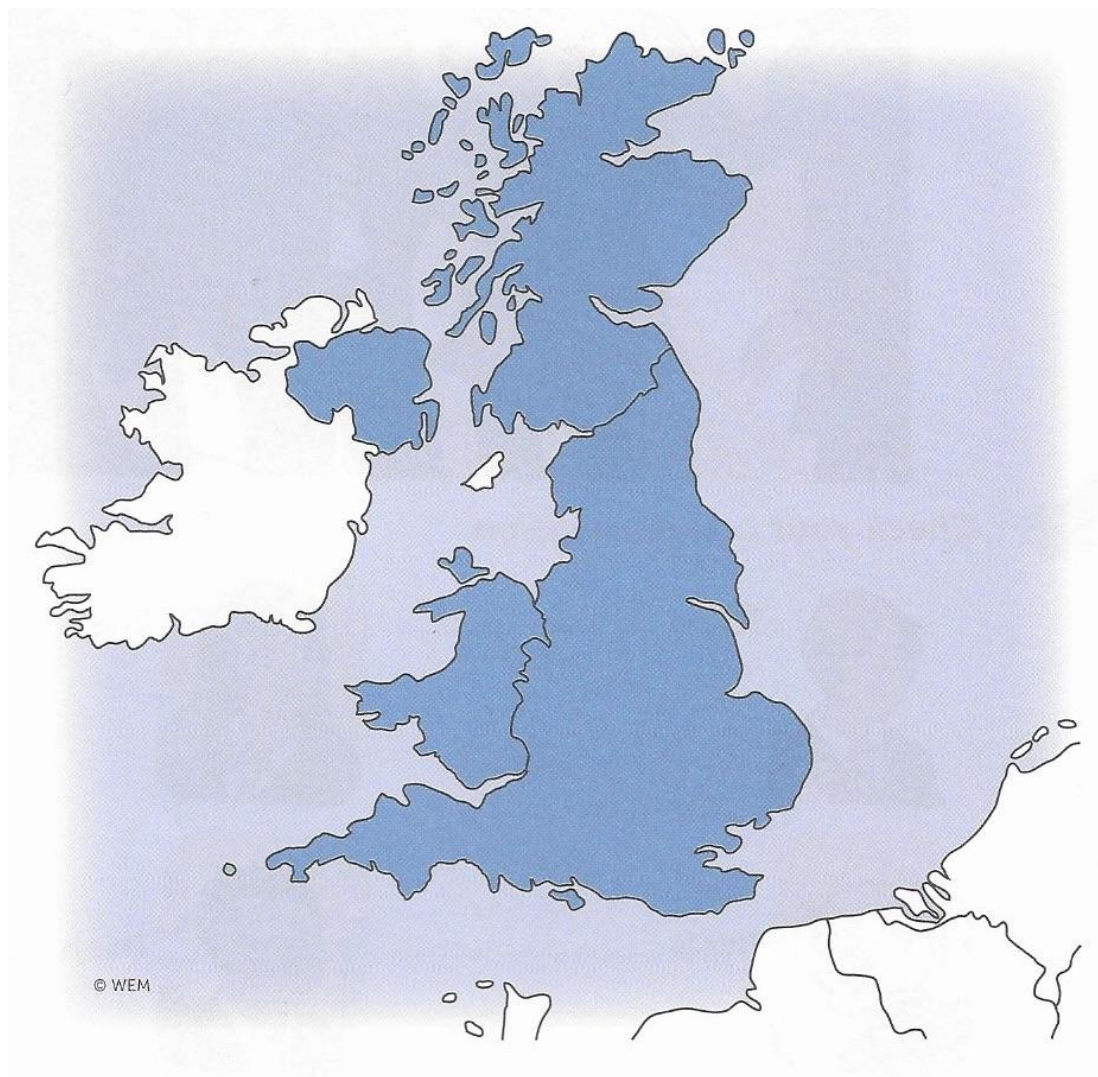
**For Scotland: a diagonal white cross**

**For Northern Ireland: a diagonal red cross**

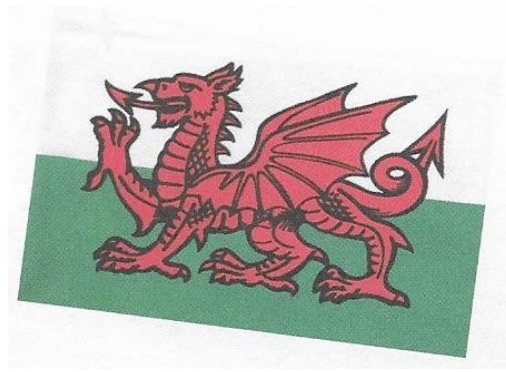

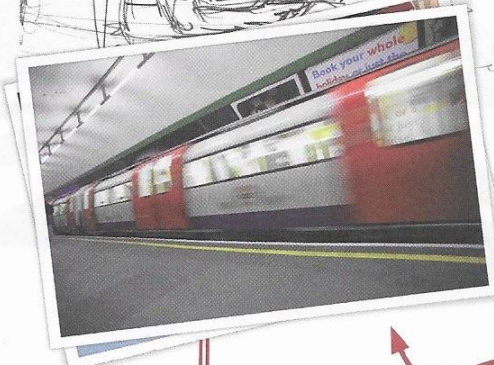
